

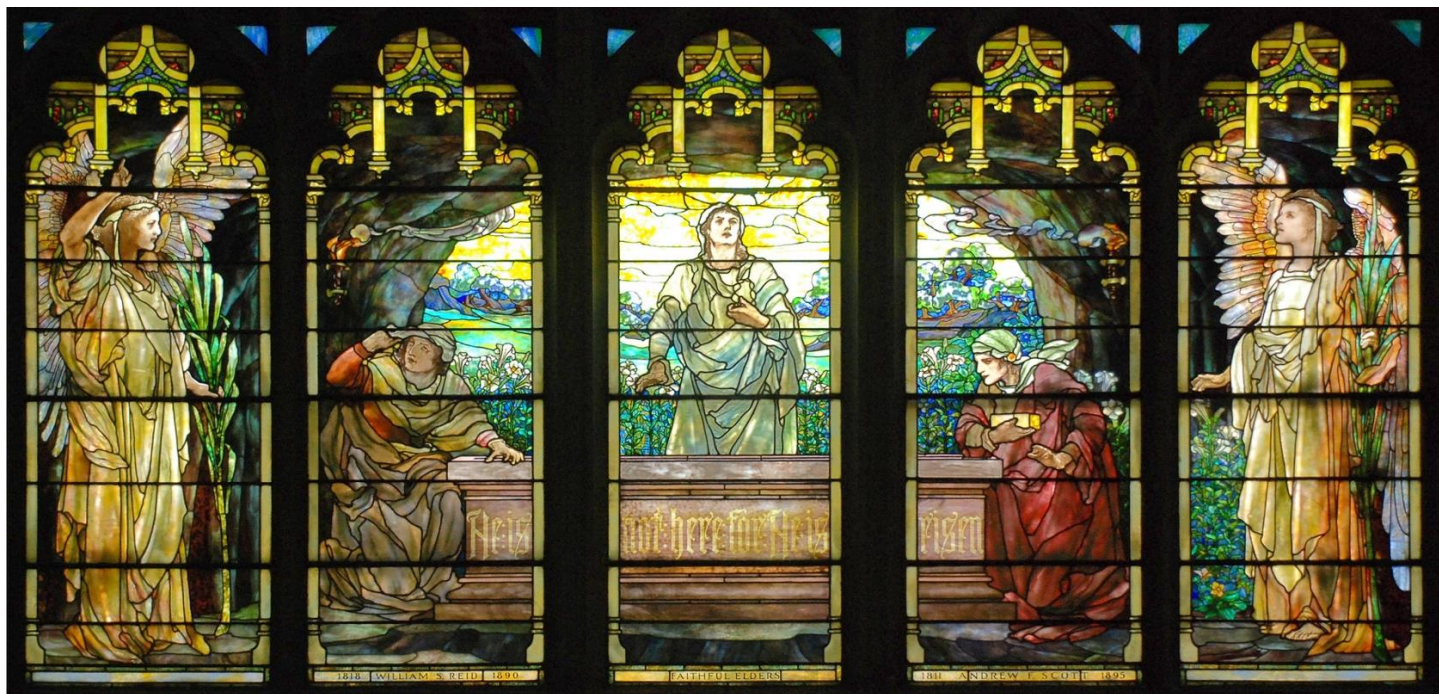

Beethoven's "Ode to Joy" becomes a rousing Easter hymn using words written by renowned British hymnist, Brian Wren, former professor of worship and mentor of Pastor Michael in seminary. Wren first wrote the words for another tune 33 years ago, but Beethoven's most famous "tune" has become synonymous with this text in contemporary hymnals.

This simple refrain of gratitude, written and composed by Michigan flutist and composer Don Fishel, is far more popular on its own than connected with the hymn that gave it birth.

BEARING AND FOLLOWING THE WORD INTO THE WORLD

Our closing hymn is a particular arrangement for brass, choir and congregation. The order of the verses is shifted and a new verse replaces one of the verses.
