The current ecumenical version of the Apostle's Creed was revised in 1986 by the English Language Liturgical Consultation, a consortium of seven ecumenical organizations representing Christians from every continent where English is spoken. Presbyterians were represented by one of those seven groups, the Consultation on Common Texts, a body made up of 23 North American Christian denominations.

Our closing hymn dates from 1996, when it was composed for a Minneapolis regional gathering of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America so that the greater church would have an Easter season hymn based on today's text.
