The Nicene Creed is the most ecumenical creed in the Christian world, considered an aid to worship and faith in Roman Catholic, Orthodox, Anglican, Lutheran and Protestant traditions. It was drafted at the Council of Nicaea in 325 C.E., the first ecumenical council of the "Christian" church. It is chosen for today because the Council of Jerusalem was the first council of the leaders of the Jewish Christfollowers who would eventually become the Christian church.
