Adult Education April 9th with Rev. Dr. Elizabeth Hopp-Peters Passion & Passover: Holy Week and the Exodus

According to the Gospels, Jesus’ last days in Jerusalem coincided with the Jewish festival of Passover, commemorating the Israelites’ deliverance from Egyptian bondage.

How are the events of Holy Week illumined against the backdrop of the Exodus story? How do the Exodus themes of resistance, liberation, and salvation lend insight and nuance to Palm Sunday, the Last Supper, the Crucifixion, and the Resurrection?

Come explore the connections between the Passion Narrative and the Book of Exodus as we ponder what gives us hope as people of faith in today’s world.

The session will be led by Rev. Dr. Elizabeth Hopp-Peters, adjunct professor of Old Testament at Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary and McCormick Theological Seminary, and former Parish Associate at Northminster Presbyterian Church.
