

Help the Homeless of Evanston This Winter! Attend Emergency Shelter Volunteer Training!

Interfaith Action of Evanston will host an emergency shelter between November 15 and March 15. The shelter will only operate when the temperature is 15 degrees or below and will rotate among six different faith communities. Teams of volunteers will sign up for specific nights, so you can volunteer once a week, once a month, or more!

There are several volunteer opportunities:

Set-up Volunteers – 8:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. – set up the cots, prepare the rooms, prepare hot drinks and greet guests as they arrive at 9:00 p.m.

Overnight Volunteers – 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. – spend the night to assist the staff person. Lights will be turned out at 10:00. Volunteers should be able to get some sleep.

Clean-up Volunteers – 6 a.m. to 7 a.m. – help wake the guests and ensure they leave the facility on time. These volunteers also assist the supervisor in taking down/storing cots, cleaning up the facility, and preparing the laundry/cots for pickup on Sunday mornings.
