## Adult Education, Juvenile Justice Issues, January 28th

On Sunday, January 28th, Heidi Linn Lambros, attorney and Director of the John Howard Illinois Legal Literacy Project (LLP) is speaking after the worship service at 11:10 a.m. in the Guild Room.

This is a follow-up program to Terri Mascherin's case in October on juvenile justice issues.

The LLP is a weekly educational program run inside the Cook County Juvenile Detention Center to educate youth about the justice system and their legal rights in court. Staff and volunteer attorneys use developmentally and age-appropriate language to help youth understand court proceedings.

The program aims to help these youth reduce stress and anxiety and empower youth to achieve better case outcomes. In another area Heidi also works with indigent criminal defendants on appeal.
