Tower Gallery Exhibit Continues

Come visit Northminster's Tower Gallery to see "Walking in Unity: Elements of the Passover Seder." This amazing exhibit, open through June 11th, features woodblock prints by artist Gabriella Boros. While Northminster members will be able to see the works at any time, the Tower Gallery will be open to the community only on Saturday, April 22nd from 7 to 9 p.m., and Sunday, June 11th from 2 to 4 p.m. Invite your friends to join you in viewing these beautiful images based on Passover and the Seder in a year when the Christian, Greek Orthodox and Jewish Calendars coincide.

This collection of Ms. Boros' work shows her interpretation of "Mi Yodea," a song sung during the Passover Seder. She has assigned botanical elements to 13 important tenets of Judaism, each of which is a cumulative stanza in the song. The exhibit also features "Four Daughters," depicting the four questions asked for the Four Sons in the Seder. The final series of woodblock prints shows the Ten Commandments, which Ms. Boros illustrates using images of human hands.
