Join Pastor Michael and members of the Session today for a conversation about the proposed Evanston Sanctuary Community Statement being considered by dozens of Evanston faith communities, faith-based organizations and secular groups. ### **Help with Hearing**



Did you know that some time ago Northminster installed a hearing loop system in the sanctuary? It sends the audio signal directly to any hearing aid with a telecoil – no background noise, no reverberation, just clear sound.

Non-hearing aid users can pick up a loop receiver and listen though a headset.
