*The pastors will once again be structuring sermons around your questions. Thank you for so many great suggestions!*

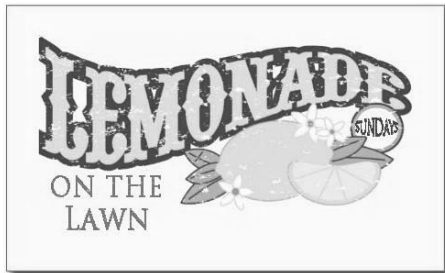
Today:
