## Adult Education, November 18th: "Living the Word" & "Living Our Faith"

Next Sunday, Rev. Elizabeth Hopp-Peters will be teaching "Living the Word" in the Library at 11:05 a.m. using the scriptures from the Narrative Lectionary. These Isaiah passages focus on the events giving rise to the prophet's declaration that "they shall beat their swords into plowshares."

At the same time, in the Guild Room, Rabbi Sam Gordon from Sukkat Shalom in Wilmette will be discussing the Israeli/Palestinian conflict from his perspective, how Israelis turn to their faith in the midst of the ongoing chaos in their homeland, and the work of Israeli peace activists, or Zionists.

Before coming to the North Shore, for 25 years Rabbi Gordon served as a rabbi in the Chicago area. In 2013, President Barack Obama appointed Rabbi Gordon to be a member of the United States Holocaust Memorial Council.
